We are happy to offer, for the very first time, Babysitting!! Some members don't get to attend training days because they don't have a sitter for their kids. FWIGT will have responsible babysitters on hand to watch members' children. There will be scheduled activities for the kids like "Floam", coloring/crafts, movie time, games etc. The parents will be required to sign their children IN and OUT of the kids' room for safety reasons. 



